

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

2. SUBMIT ENROLMENT FORM

3. ISSUANCE OF OFFER LETTER & INVOICE

4. STUDENT TO SUBMIT REQUIRED DOCUMENTS AND FULL PAYMENT

5. REVIEW OF DOCUMENTS BY UNIVERSITY (8 to 10 weeks prior to commencement)

6. ISSUANCE OF ACCEPTANCE LETTER BY UNIVERSITY (6 to 8 weeks prior to commencement)

7. STUDENT TO APPLY FOR D-4-1 VISA AT KOREAN EMBASSY (processing time varies)

8. ARRIVAL GUIDE & INSURANCE INFORMATION TO BE SENT TO STUDENT

VISA APPLICATION REQUIRED DOCUMENTS

- ID Photo (3,5x4,5cm)
- Copy of applicant's passport biodata page
- Applicant's graduation certificate and transcript from last school attended (Notarized of Apostille)
- Original bank statement of applicant or parents' with active balance of USD10,000 or above (In the event applicants are submitting documents in parents' name, certificate of family relations such as the Certificate of Birth must be submitted)
- A Letter of Self-Introduction & Study Plan either in Korean or English
- * Visa documents issuance is subject to the result of application review
- * All documents not in English or Korean will be required to be translated and certified
- * Depending on the student's nationality, additional documents may be required
- * Student will be permitted to work after 180 days of stay
